

Cegep – Course Advanced Standing

Students having completed at least 17 admissible courses from Cegep can receive up to 30 units in advanced standing at **admission in program offered by the Faculty of Science**. Students having completed less than 12 admissible courses cannot receive advanced standing.

Admissible courses: all courses except physical education and upgrading courses.

The following equivalent courses are usually granted for students having completed the Cegep Science Program according to the requirements of their program of studies.

Advanced standing for elective courses will be granted according to the courses completed at Cegep up to an overall maximum of 30 units (10 courses).

Equivalent courses indicated are based on courses offered at Heritage College. Course codes and titles may vary according to the institution attended.
